

The Institute of Emergency Services and Homeland Security
is presently looking for new **Live Fire Instructors**.

Minimum qualifications for Live Fire Instructor:

- 1) Fire Instructor I Certification or equivalent advanced instructor certification.
- 2) Current certification at the Firefighter I & II levels through UFRA.
- 3) Two years experience teaching Firefighting related courses.

This will be a competitive process and all candidates are required to go through the application procedures and possibly an oral interview before selection for a Train the Trainer course. Successful completion of the Train the Trainer will require passing a written exam and an individual teach-back assignment. Those who successfully complete the Train the Trainer will be considered new Live Fire Instructors for the following props: Propane, FEAST/IFA, and Flashover. UFRA will cover travel costs, housing, and meals for this T-t-T, but cannot provide any hourly compensation for this training.

The next T-t-T is scheduled for June 27 or 28, 2008 at UFRA.

Those interested should complete the following requirements:

- 1) Submit a letter of interest describing your qualifications, experience, and your reasons for wanting to participate as an instructor.
- 2) Submit copies of all required certifications and credentials.
- 3) Submit a current, professional resume.
- 4) Provide documentation of the two year fire instructor requirement.
- 5) Submit two letters of recommendation which address your instructional abilities and technical qualifications. Letters should be from past or present supervisors, training officers, faculty members, or Chiefs.

Upon successful acceptance as an instructor, a UVSC application for employment will need to be filled out with the UVSC Human Resources department.

All of the above requirements need to be submitted in person or by certified mail (recommended) and received by the close of business on **16 June 2008**.
